**25** children out of **1000** live births die before the age of **1**



**34.8%** of children aged **36-59** months are not developmentally on track



The third-grade children unable to solve **56.5%** of the reading and **62.78%** of the math-related problems



**> 80%** of children under the age of **14** experience psychological aggression and/or physical punishment



**1.1 million** children between age **5 to 17** are involved in child labor



Around **34%** of children below the age of **17** years are multi-dimensionally poor



Children and women in Nepal are disproportionately at risk to multiple shocks and disasters
