If your group is successful, we will support you in the following ways:

1. Five members from your group/network/organization will be invited to attend our 3 days (**24 May – 26 May 2022**) co-creation workshop where we will help you design your campaign plan.
2. The selected ones will be matched with leading creatives to develop ideas that will help your campaign stand out from the crowd.
3. Your campaign will receive funding so you can bring your campaign to life.
4. Save the Children Nepal and WWF Nepal will support you every step of the way.

+ Criteria for Assessment

We will judge applications based on the following criteria:

1. Is your group/network/organization well established and active? Are you enthusiastic about participating?
2. Does your group/network/organization have a clear goal and focus?
3. Is your group/network/organization comprised of youth (under 25s) with up to 15 available to attend workshops and lead the campaign?
4. Is your vision achievable within the political and social constraints of your location?
5. Can Shift help enable your success?
6. Is it likely that your group's activities will continue into the future, after Shift's support ends?

+ Approval process

Phase	Activity
Submission	Applications received
Assessment	Shift team reviews applications and assess against criteria
Review	Interview arranged with one or two leading applicants
Decision	Successful applicant notified. kick-off meeting held Unsuccessful applicants notified. All applications received will be kept for future opportunities and youth groups will still be able to connect with and support Shift enabled campaigns.
